



"GEAR UP AND DRIVE OFF" NATIONAL COMPETITION

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. PROMOTER

1.1 This promotional competition ("the Competition") is conducted by **ZK Intelligent Solutions (Pty) Ltd** in partnership with **Regal Distributors SA (Pty) Ltd and Reditron (Pty) Ltd** (collectively referred to as "the Promoter").

1.2 These Terms and Conditions govern the Competition and all participation therein.

2. COMPETITION PERIOD

2.1 The Competition will run from **1 June 2026 to 28 February 2027** ("the Competition Period").

2.2 Entries close at **close of business on 28 February 2027**.

2.3 No late entries will be accepted under any circumstances.

3. ELIGIBILITY

3.1 The Competition is open to:

- Registered security installers, electrical contractors, and qualifying businesses
- Legal residents and/or citizens of the Republic of South Africa
- Persons aged **18 years or older**

3.2 Participants must be in possession of a valid South African identity document.

3.3 To qualify for the vehicle prize, participants must hold a valid South African driver's licence or nominate a suitable alternative recipient, subject to approval by the Promoter.

3.4 The following persons are excluded from participation:

- Directors, employees, agents, contractors, or consultants of the Promoter
- Immediate family members, business partners, or associates of such persons

3.5 Any participant found to be ineligible will be disqualified.

4. ENTRY MECHANICS

4.1 To enter the Competition, participants must:

- Purchase ZKTeco products from any Regal or Reditron branch during the Competition Period
- Spend a minimum of **R7 500 (excluding VAT) per invoice**

4.2 Each qualifying invoice constitutes **one (1) entry** into the Competition.

4.3 Multiple entries are permitted, provided each entry meets the minimum spend requirement.



4.4 Each entry must:

- Correspond to a **single invoice only**
- Official QR code must be scanned and completed.
- The official entry form must include all required participant details and clear photo of invoice.

4.5 Entries that are incomplete, illegible, fraudulent, or not in accordance with these Terms and Conditions will be deemed invalid.

5. ENTRY VALIDATION

5.1 All entries will be subject to verification and audit by the Promoter.

5.2 The Promoter reserves the right to disqualify any entry where:

- The invoice has not been paid in full
- The invoice has been credited, reversed, or refunded
- Fraud, manipulation, or abuse is suspected

5.3 The Promoter's internal records shall be the sole and final evidence of valid entry.

6. PRIZES

6.1 The prizes are as follows:

- **First Prize:** Suzuki Eco vehicle (approximate value R250,000)
- **Second Prize:** Business Growth Kit (approximate value R50,000)
- **Third Prize:** Installer Toolkit (approximate value R25,000)
- **Additional prizes:** 2 Camp Master Wilderness 300 trailers

6.2 Prizes are:

- Not transferable
- Not refundable
- Not exchangeable for cash

6.3 The Promoter reserves the right to substitute any prize with another of equal or greater value should circumstances require.

7. PRIZE CONDITIONS

7.1 In respect of the vehicle prize:

- The Promoter will cover initial vehicle registration and licensing
- The winner is responsible for:
 - Insurance
 - Maintenance
 - Fuel
 - Any additional costs associated with ownership

7.2 The winner must comply with all legal requirements to take ownership of the vehicle.

7.3 Should a winner be unable to accept the prize; the Promoter reserves the right to award it to an alternative winner.



8. DRAW PROCESS

- 8.1 Winners will be selected by means of a **random draw** from all valid entries.
- 8.2 The draw will be conducted under the supervision of an independent auditor, attorney, or commissioner of oaths.
- 8.3 The Promoter may, at its discretion, conduct a multi-stage draw process.

9. WINNER NOTIFICATION

- 9.1 Winners will be notified telephonically using the contact details provided.
- 9.2 If a winner:

- Cannot be contacted within **five (5) days**, or
- Declines the prize

the Promoter reserves the right to select an alternative winner.

- 9.3 A maximum of three (3) replacement winners may be drawn per prize.

10. WINNER REQUIREMENTS

- 10.1 Winners must provide:

- A valid South African identity document
- Proof of purchase, if requested

- 10.2 Winners may be required to attend a prize-giving or final draw event.

- 10.3 Failure to comply may result in forfeiture of the prize.

11. LIMITATION OF PRIZES

- 11.1 Each participant may win only **one (1) prize** in the Competition.

12. PERSONAL INFORMATION (POPIA)

12.1 By entering the Competition, participants consent to the collection and processing of their personal information for purposes related to the Competition.

12.2 Personal information will be handled in accordance with the **Protection of Personal Information Act (POPIA)**.

12.3 Participants may opt in or out of receiving future marketing communications.

13. PUBLICITY

13.1 Winners may be requested to participate in marketing and promotional activities.

13.2 This may include the use of:

- Names
- Photographs
- Video recordings

13.3 Participation is voluntary and may be declined.



14. INVALID ENTRIES

14.1 Entries will be deemed invalid if they are:

- Incomplete
- Illegible
- Fraudulent
- Altered or tampered with

14.2 The Promoter accepts no responsibility for lost, delayed, or damaged entries.

15. LIABILITY

15.1 To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Promoter shall not be liable for:

- Any loss, damage, or injury
- Any claims arising directly or indirectly from participation in the Competition
- Any issues related to the acceptance or use of any prize

16. PROMOTER RIGHTS

16.1 The Promoter reserves the right to:

- Disqualify participants.
- Cancel, suspend, extend or terminate the competition.
- Substitute prizes where necessary.

16.2 Participants waive any claims against the Promoter arising from such actions.

17. FRAUD AND ABUSE

17.1 The Promoter reserves the right to investigate any suspicious activity.

17.2 Any attempt to manipulate the Competition will result in immediate disqualification.

18. FORCE MAJEURE

18.1 The Promoter shall not be liable for failure or delay in performing its obligations where such failure arises from events beyond its reasonable control.

19. TAX

19.1 Any tax liability arising from acceptance of a prize shall be the sole responsibility of the winner.

20. ACCEPTANCE OF TERMS

20.1 Participation in the Competition constitutes full acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.

20.2 Participants confirm that they are legally entitled to enter.
